

CALL FOR PHD APPLICATIONS

Department of General Linguistics, Palacký University in Olomouc, Czech Republic, offers a unique PhD Program in Linguistics and Digital Humanities (LDH). LDH attracts bright students, young researchers, and professors at the interdisciplinary and international level. Digital Humanities at The Faculty of Arts, Palacký University is a four-year doctoral program, which is closely connected with applied research and practical application of the results of theoretical research. The study is focused on linguistic text analysis in connection with current methods of data mining, which is further applicable in the sphere of application or in research in the humanities. The program is based on three main research orientations:

- the use of linguistic description for analysis of digitalized text,
- analysis of the digitalized text for use by the humanities (philology, history, arts, etc.),
- linguistic analysis of the genetic text.

The scholarships are fully-funded for up to four years (no tuition fees), with a possibility of extra scholarships in case of excellent results or extra activities (the minimal basic scholarship amount is € 443 EUR netto/month). Palacký University offers economic housing in the Palacký University campus. All students will have free daily access to the canteen, PhD office, and library.
